NO ADDITIONAL CHARGE TO:**

1. All Temple Emanuel MEMBERS in good standing, as of August 2010
2. Parents of members who reside in a member's household on a year-round basis
3. Members' children entering the 4th grade or above
4. Members' children who are full-time students
5. Members' children who are **not full-time students**, but are 25 or older **and** reside **outside** Camden, Burlington or Gloucester County
6. Newlywed children of members
7. Members' guests and family who are members of another reform congregation of the URJ (A completed "Request for High Holy Day Seating" form, obtained through the URJ office or the guests' synagogue, must be submitted)

GUEST TICKETS AT A COST OF \$200 EACH ARE AVAILABLE TO:

1. Members' children over age 25, non-students, residing in Camden, Burlington or Gloucester County
2. Members' immediate family, excluding children, who reside outside Camden, Burlington or Gloucester County
